



#### GROWING SEASON NOTES

The 2022 growing season began with a dry winter and early bud break, setting the stage for a fast-paced vintage. A warm, consistent summer followed, with heat spikes in late August accelerating ripening. Careful vineyard management was essential to maintain balance and protect fruit integrity during these critical weeks.

#### VINEYARD NOTES

The Langtry Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from high elevation hillside vineyards overlooking the estate reservoir and Putah Creek. These mountain sites feature thin, gravelly loam and volcanic soils characteristic of premier Bordeaux terroir. The hillside exposure and elevation provide optimal drainage and temperature control, while the volcanic soils contribute mineral complexity and concentrated fruit character, producing wines with exceptional structure and longevity.

#### WINEMAKING NOTES

The Cabernet Sauvignon grapes were hand-harvested and destemmed into stainless steel tanks for fermentation. Gentle pumpovers coaxed out the color and tannins, while an extended maceration (24 days on skins) helped resolve the tannins. Post-pressing and Malolactic fermentation, the wine was put to French oak barrels – 30% new. The final blend was assembled just prior to the next vintage and returned to barrel for a total of 24 months oak aging.

#### TASTING NOTES

The 2022 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is dominated by luscious black/ blue fruits, with enticing baking spice flavors and aromas. The entrance is juicy, with a rich, dense midpalate and fine-grained supple tannins and a long finish that lasts.
