"It's truly exciting to see Lake County winegrowing come into its own. For many years, growers have worked diligently to finetune farming in Lake County's young volcanic soils, rugged topography, and high-elevation climate, and they have remained dedicated to producing quality fruit through sustainable, organic, and regenerative viticultural practices," shared Debra Sommerfield, president, Lake County Winegrape Commission. "The result is mountain-grown grapes with excellent phenolics, tannins, structure, and balance – and winemakers across California have really come to appreciate the value Lake County grapes bring to their wine programs."

"Sauvignon Blanc of course continues to be a pretty strong leader in one of only a few growth areas of the total wine market. According to Nielsen data for the last 52 weeks ended April 19, 2025, Sauvignon Blanc has seen a 3.1% growth in sales value while other varieties are in a negative decline."

LILLIE'S VINEYARD SAUVIGNON BLANC

This wine is fresh, zesty, with aromas of green guava, kiwi, citrus blossom, and notes of white florals on the nose. The flavors on the palate are kaffir lime, white grapefruit, white nectarine, sedimentary rock, interwoven with good acidity, and a long juicy finish. pair with tinned fish, marinated green olive, red bell pepper, herbed olive oil.





This wine is lively, supple, with aromas of citrus, green apple, white tea, and notes of dried herbs on the nose. The flavors on the palate are white nectarine, white grapefruit zest, quince, gliding into white pepper, white blossom honey, and a long dry supple finish. pair with seared bay scallop, citrus, papaya, snap pea salad

FEATHER BOA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2022

Lillie Feather Boa is a youthful, more ready-to-drink bottling from Langtry, a legacy producer known for its age-worthy wines from high-elevation volcanic locations. This one does not disappoint, with aromatics of Bing cherry, mulberry, graham crackers, dried nutmeg, and star anise on the nose. Hints of cranberry and raspberry skip across the palate, creating a mouth-watering texture and supple finish. Decant and pair with roasted Cornish hens stuffed with sausage, mushroom, chestnuts, sweet cornbread stuffing — [Tonya Pitts](#)
